Did you know that 75 years ago (in October of 1946) the first worship service for Eastern Heights Lutheran Church was held in a rented portable classroom building on the grounds of Eastern Heights public school at Ruth and Margaret Streets? The "Ruth Avenue Mission" met every Sunday and organized as Eastern Heights Evangelical Lutheran Congregation in February of 1947. Later that year, the property here at Ruth and 5th Streets began to be developed with a basement church.
